

John 1: 29-34

The next day he saw Jesus coming towards him and declared, 'Here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! This is he of whom I said, "After me comes a man who ranks ahead of me because he was before me." I myself did not know him; but I came baptizing with water for this reason, that he might be revealed to Israel.' And testified, 'I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it remained on him. I myself did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water said to me, "He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain is the one who baptizes with the Holy Spirit." Bishop's Message

FIRST SUNDAY AFTER THE EPIPHANY

Dear Brothers and Sisters.

On this first Sunday after the Epiphany, we read from the Gospel of John (1:29-34), where Saint John the Baptist provides testimony regarding the Baptism of Jesus. Reflecting on this passage, we are reminded of the profound significance that the sacrament of Baptism holds in the Christian faith. It goes beyond being a mere formality; instead, it is an act that deeply impacts our existence, transforming us and connecting us as living members to Christ and His Church.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (n. 1262-1266) outlines two primary effects of Baptism. Firstly, Baptism serves as a purification of sins, symbolised by the proclamation, "Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world" (John 1:29). Through Baptism, all sins, both original and personal, are forgiven.

Secondly, Baptism is the descent of the Holy Spirit, as articulated in the statement, "He baptises with the Holy Spirit" (John 1:34). This transformative sacrament makes us a "new creation," adopted children of God, participants in the divine nature, members of Christ, co-heirs with Him, and temples of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Trinity bestows upon us sanctifying grace, enabling us to believe in God, hope in Him, and love Him. It empowers us to live under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, utilising His gifts, and to grow in goodness through moral virtues.

The Feast of the Epiphany is a day often chosen by families for baptising their children, and our parishes celebrate numerous baptisms on this special day. Our prayers extend to all the children recently baptised, that the graces of their baptism may accompany them all their lives.

Inspired by Pope Francis' call to "reawaken the memory of our Baptism," we are urged to live out our Baptism daily as the present reality of our lives. Despite our limitations, weaknesses, and sins, if we follow Jesus and remain in the Church, it is precisely through the Sacrament of Baptism that we become new creatures and are clothed in Christ. "It is by the power of Baptism, in fact, that, freed of original sin, we are inserted into Jesus' relation to God the Father; that we are bearers of a new hope, for Baptism gives us this new hope: the hope of going on the path of salvation our whole life long. And this hope nothing and no one can extinguish, for it is a hope that does not disappoint." (General Audience, 8 January 2014).

May we continuously embrace the transformative power of Baptism, living in communion with God and our neighbour, and allowing the Holy Spirit to guide our lives along the path of virtue and love.

Reflection of the Week "Lamb of God"

In the Season of the Epiphany the focus is on Jesus, the baptised one, who in today's Gospel is referred to as the Lamb of God.


We get the reference Lamb of God from the Passover story we read in Exodus 12:21 where a lamb was slaughtered and the blood painted on the post of the homes of the Hebrews in order to avoid the Angel of Death. Jesus was referred later to as the Paschal (Passover) Lamb, who saved the people from death, by his salvific life.

However, we can see another side to this title. Jesus is described as the Lamb of God and yet in John's Gospel we also read Jesus describing himself as the 'good shepherd' (Jn 10:11). He is both lamb and shepherd and if we think about this more deeply, it is a lesson for us to learn.

Jesus is God's Son, and he can do nothing without God. Jesus is obedient to the Father, just as the lamb (sheep) follow the Shepherd. Yet it is not a paternalistic image. In following God, one learns and grows to become like God. The one who is the lamb, obedient to death, is the one who became the Shepherd.

God calls us to follow him not to be mere spectators and servants but in order that we too may become like God. On our own we can do very little. With God we can become so much more. Amen

كلمة الحياة غذاءً للنفوس

في إنجيل اليوم، يتحدّث يوحنا المعمدان مع إسرائيل الجديد، أي جميع الذين سيؤمنون بيسوع المسيح ربًّا ومُخلِّصًا، ليدخل بهم إلى العهد الجديد الكامل والأبدي. ويؤكّد لهم أن المسيح يأتي، لا في صورة ملوكية مجيدة كما يظن اليهود، بل كإنسان متألم، مجده الحبّ الذي سيحمل خطايا العالم.

نرى هنا أنّه، برغُم أن يوحنا المعمدان كان مبشّرًا معروفًا ومشهورًا جذب الله جموعًا كثيرة، إلّا أنه كان مسرورًا أن يأخذ يسوع المكانة الأسمى، فلم يحتفظ بشيء من المجد لذاته بل أعطاه بالكامل لمَن هو له.

لقد كانت مهمة يوحنا المعمدان هي توجيه الشعب إلى يسوع المسيح الذين كانوا يتطلعون إليه. اليوم يتطلع كثير من الناس إلى مَن يعطيهم الأمان والسلام في عالم غير آمن.

مهمتنا أن نساعد الجميع ليتوجهوا إلى المسيح، ليعرفوا أنه هو فقط مَن يجب أن يبحثوا عنه، وأنه فيه فقط سيجدون جميع الكنوز التي يحتاجونها، وأنه هو وحده مَن يستطيع أن يمنحهم السلام والأمان الحقيقيين.

في هذا الإطار، علينا أن نشهد للمسيح كما شهد له يوحنا المعمدان وخاصتة بالتواضع الذي يبقى أساس العظمة في الكرازة والتعليم أو أي خدمة أو عمل رعوي نؤديه للمسيح. فحينما نقوم بعمل يكلفنا به الربّ، علينا، كي يكتمل فرحنا، أن نترك كرامة العمل ومجده له، فهو الذي يصنع بنا ومن خلالنا أعمالاً عظيمة لخلاص النفوس.

علينًا أن نسعى في حياتنا، على الدوام، أن يكون لدينا وضوح الرؤية فنميّز وجه الربّ يسوع وحضوره، في الأحداث والأشخاص، فنشهد له بقوّة وبجرأة على مثال يوحنّا المعمدان. www.kobayat.org


