

The Gospel

Mark 10: 46-52

They came to Jericho. As Jesus and his disciples and a large crowd were leaving Jericho, Bartimaeus son of Timaeus, a blind beggar, was sitting by the roadside. When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to shout out and say, 'Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!' Many sternly ordered him to be quiet, but he cried out even more loudly, 'Son of David, have mercy on me!' Jesus stood still and said, 'Call him here.' And they called the blind man, saying to him, 'Take heart; get up, he is calling you.' So throwing off his cloak, he sprang up and came to Jesus. Then Jesus said to him, What do you want me to do for you?' The blind man said to him, 'My teacher, let me see again.' Jesus said to him, 'Go; your faith has made you well.' Immediately he regained his sight and followed him on the way.

Bishops Message Year of Prayer

Sunday of the Blind, Beatification of Patriarch Estephan El Douaihy and Feast of Saint Joseph

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Pope Francis authorised this week the promulgation of a decree recognising the miracle attributed to the intercession of the Venerable Servant of God Estephan El Douaihy paving the way for his beatification in Lebanon on the 2nd of August 2024.

Estephan El Douaihy, born in Ehden, Lebanon, in 1630, dedicated his life to the service of the Maronite Church and the pursuit of knowledge. After studying in Rome and being ordained a priest, he served diligently in various parishes and eventually became the Bishop of the Maronite Diocese of Cyprus. Known for his reforms and writings, he was elected the 57th Patriarch of the Maronite Church in 1670. He played a crucial role in preserving the traditions of the Maronite Church while facing challenges from Ottoman authorities.

The news of his upcoming beatification is cause for great joy in Lebanon and beyond. We thank the Lord for this blessing to our Church. May the prayers of Venerable Estephan El Douaihy be with us all.

Feast of St Joseph

This week, on the 19th of March, we celebrate the feast of Saint Joseph, a much beloved saint. We reflect on his profound role in the life of Jesus and the Holy Family. In the Gospel narratives, Joseph emerges as a man of dreams, through which God communicates important messages to him. These dreams highlight the ongoing presence of fear and danger in his life and the important task he was entrusted with: to protect Jesus and His Mother Mary. Joseph's faith and reliance on prayer allowed him to navigate uncertainty with confidence in God's plan.

Today, we remember those burdened by life's challenges, who struggle to find hope and solace. We ask Saint Joseph to intercede for them, guiding them towards dialogue with God and illuminating their path with light and peace.

Sunday of the Blind

On this Sunday of Lent, the Maronite Church reflects on the Gospel of the healing of the blind man. The story of the healing of Bartimaeus portrays the great courage of a man who despite his disability knew exactly what he wanted. Although Bartimaeus was physically blind, his faith led him to believe that Jesus was the Messiah, the chosen one, and he called out: "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me". This Gospel passage is not only about the faith of Bartimaeus. It is also about the lack of faith of the disciples, who professed that Jesus was the Messiah in words, but were blinded to the fact that Jesus' mission of salvation had to go through the Cross. Although it was the disciples who called Bartimaeus, saying to him: "take heart, he is calling you", it was Bartimaeus who had the faith to see and understand who Jesus was.

Through the faith of Bartimaeus, we can see examine our faith especially in times of adversity. When fear clouds our vision and blinds us to the perspective of faith, do we, like Bartimaeus, cry out to Jesus for mercy and assistance? When fear grips us, it not only distances us from God and the Church but also isolates us from our loved ones. Regrettably, in our blindness, we may fail to recognise our family, friends, or the Church beckoning us with words of encouragement: "Take heart, get up, he is calling you."

In this Season of Lent, may we turn to God in prayer, seeking the clarity of vision to recognise His presence and the courage to respond to His call.

Beatification of Patriarch Estephan El Douaihy

Pope Francis authorised this week the promulgation of a decree recognising the miracle attributed to the intercession of the Venerable Servant of God Estephan El Douaihy paving the way for his beatification in Lebanon on the 2nd of August 2024.

Born Estephan Boutros El Douaihy in Ehden in 1630, the Venerable Patriarch became the 57th Maronite Patriarch, contributing significantly to the construction of numerous churches and monasteries while playing a pivotal role in preserving the unique identity of the Maronite Church. He was also esteemed as one of the most prominent Maronite and Lebanese historians and authors.

The beatification is scheduled to be held at the Patriarchal See in Bkerke on Friday 2 August, coinciding with the birthday of Venerable El Douaihy. Further details about the celebration will be provided in due course.

May the bells of our Maronite Churches toll in joyful celebration, Alleluia!

Feast of the Annunciation

The universal Church traditionally celebrates the Feast of the Annunciation on 25th March.

However, given that this year the Feast falls on Monday of Passion Week, His Beatitude and Eminence has directed that the Feast is to be moved to Wednesday 3rd April 2024.


