

The Gospel

Luke 24: 36-48

While they were talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, 'Peace be with you.' They were startled and terrified, and thought that they were seeing a ghost. He said to them, 'Why are you frightened, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? Look at my hands and my feet; see that it is I myself. Touch me and see; for a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have.' And when he had said this, he showed them his hands and his feet. While in their joy they were disbelieving and still wondering, he said to them, 'Have you anything here to eat?' They gave him a piece of broiled fish, and he took it and ate in their presence. Then he said to them, These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you that everything written about me in the law of Moses, the prophets, and the psalms must be fulfilled.' Then he opened their minds to understand the scriptures, and he said to them, 'Thus it is written, that the Messiah is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day, and that repentance and forgiveness of sins is to be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things.

فِيهَا الرُّسُلُ يَتَكَلَّمُونَ بِهِذَا، وَقَفَ يَسُوعُ في وَسَطِهِم، وقَالَ لَهُم: «أَلسَّلامُ لَكُم!». فأرْتَاعُوا، وأَسْتَوْلى عَلَيْهِم الخَوْف، وكَانُوا يَظُنُّونَ أَنَّهُم يُشَاهِدُونَ رُوحًا. فقَالَ لَهُم يَسُوع: «مَا بَالُكُم مُضْطَربين؟ وَلِمَاذَا تُخَالِجُ هذِهِ الأَفْكَارُ قُلُوبَكُم؟ أُنْظُرُوا إلى يَدَىَّ وَرِجْلَيَّ، فَإِنِّي أَنَا هُوَ. جُسُّونِي، وٱنْظُرُوا، فإِنَّ الرُّوحَ لا لَحْمَ لَهُ وَلا عِظَامَ كَمَا تَرَوْنَ لِي!». قالَ هذَا وَأَرَاهُم يَدَيْهِ وَرجْلَيْه. وَإِذْ كَانُوا بَعْدُ غَيْرَ مُصَدِّقِينَ مِنَ الفَرَح، وَمُتَعَجِّبِين، قَالَ لَهُم: «هَلْ عِنْدَكُم هُنَا طَعَام؟». فَقَدَّمُوا لَهُ قِطْعَةً مِنْ سَمَكِ مَشْوى، وَمِنْ شَهْدِ عَسَل. فَأَخَذَهَا وَأَكَلَهَا بِمَرْأًى مِنْهُم، وقَالَ لَهُم: «هذَا هُوَ كَلامِي الَّذي كَلَّمْتُكُم بِهِ، وَأَنا بَعْدُ مَعَكُم. كَانَ يَنْبَغِي أَنْ يَتِمَّ كُلُّ مَا كُتِبَ عَنِّي في تَوْرَاةِ مُوسَى، وَالأَنْبِيَاءِ وَالْمَزَامِيرِ». حِينَئِذِ فَتَحَ أَذْهَانَهُم لِيَفْهَمُوا الكُتُب. ثُمَّ قالَ لَهُم: «هكذَا مَكْتُوبٌ أَنَّ المَسِيحَ يَتَأَلَّم، وَيَقُومُ مِنْ بَيْنِ الأَمْوَاتِ في اليَوْمِ الثَّالِث. وبِٱسْمِهِ يُكْرَزُ بِالتَّوْبَةِ لِمَغْفِرةِ الخَطَايَا، في جَمِيعِ الأُمَم، إِنْتِدَاءً مِنْ أُورَشَلِيمٍ. وأَنْتُم شُهُودٌ عَلَى ذَلِكَ.

Bishops Message Year of Prayer 6th Sunday of the Resurrection

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As we gather on this first Sunday of May, the Maronite Church celebrates the Feast of Our Lady of Lebanon, patroness of Lebanon. In our prayers, we entrust to her maternal care our beloved Lebanon which continues to endure challenges and tribulations.

The Church is the assembly of saints and we believe in the communion of saints. The source of all this is the love of God who leads His people to form in Christ one holy family, the Church. This takes a special meaning for us as we celebrate this Sunday the upcoming beatification of the Venerable Patriarch Estephan El Douaihy, almost 320 years after his death on the third of May 1704.

In the Catholic Church, the death of a holy person is remembered as their "spiritual birthday" and usually becomes their feast day, because it is on that day they are born to eternal life. We pray that this great Patriarch will eventually be canonised as a saint of the Church: a model of holy living for all Christians.

Patriarch El Douaihy is the first Maronite patriarch to be beatified. He is known as "the memory of the Maronite Church" because he, more than anyone else, made a determined effort to gather the history of our Maronite liturgy, spirituality, and history that were already being lost. His dedication ensured the continuity and preservation of our Maronite faith.

When still a bishop, he approved the process of the formation of the monastic orders in Lebanon. He gave his blessing to the efforts of three men from Aleppo, efforts which have since blossomed into the Lebanese Maronite Order and also the Marian Order of Monks.

Patriarch El Douaihy can be described as a "hero in the school of holiness." Despite facing daunting challenges, such as travelling Lebanon on foot to evade persecution, navigating treacherous terrain of hills and rocks, he remained steadfast in his leadership, faith and determination. His spirit and teachings endure, and his prayers continue to accompany us, children of the Maronite Church. He is ever-present in our Divine Liturgy, in Lebanon's history and the broader history of the Church.

The Maronite Church worldwide celebrates with joy his upcoming beatification. In Australia, our community joyfully commemorates the life and spiritual legacy of Patriarch El Douaihy with a celebration on Sunday and the unveiling of his statue at Our Lady of Lebanon Co-Cathedral (Harris Park).

We pray to the Lord, through the intercession of Our Lady of Lebanon, to bless us with more men and women of holiness from within our midst. May they guide us along the path of sanctity and support us with their prayers.

Reflection of the Week: "Understand Scripture"

The resurrected Jesus makes another appearance in this Sunday's Gospel passage but once again we read of the disciples' doubts and their struggle to believe. What does it take to believe in Christ?

Jesus does a number of things in his appearance to the disciples. Firstly, he makes a sudden appearance among them. Secondly, he offers them peace. However, these two efforts only 'startled and terrified' the disciples.

On the third, fourth and fifth attempts, Jesus talks to the disciples, shows them the scars and his hands and feet as evidence of the crucifixion and even invites them to touch his hands and feet. The disciples' response was that they were 'disbelieving and still wondering' (v41).

So, on the sixth attempt Jesus eats broiled fish before their very eyes. It doesn't seem to have convinced them for Jesus then makes a seventh attempt. Jesus 'opened their minds to understand the Scriptures' (v45). After that he promises them the gift of the Holy Spirit. So, what does it all mean?

Christ is always with us, whether we believe it or not. Christ offers us endless opportunities to come to knowledge of God. It is our willingness to see, hear and engage that will determine our depth of faith. What is most important is that we read and understand Scripture. Belief without engaging in the Bible, lacks depth. We need to constantly hear God's word, written down, for believers to deepen their faith generation after generation. Amen

كلمة الحياة غذاءً للنفوس

ربط لوقًا هذه الرواية بما سبقها. حدّد كاتب الإنجيل الثالث: "وفيما هم يتكلّمون بهذا"، أي فيما الحديث جار بين تلميذيّ عمّاوس اللّدين كانا يخبر إن بما حدث في الطريق، وكيف عرفًا

يسوع عند كسر الخبز، وبين الأحد عشر والذين كانوا مجتمعين معهم، الذين كانوا يقولون إن الربّ حقًا قام، وتراءى لسمعان. فيضع هذا الربط القارئ على بيّنة، من أنّ ما سيجري، يأتي في الخطّ ذاته لما جرى سابقًا. فالربّ ظهر وبيّن أهميّة الكتب المقدّسة، وكشف عن ذاته عند كسر الخبز. تحتل أحداث القيامة وتراثيات الربّ يسوع التميذه مكانة هامّة في كلّ المنتال المنتال

الأناجيل. فمِن خلال هذه الترائيات يُبيّن كُلُّ من الإنجيليّين كيف أنَّ يُسوع أظهر ذاته لتلاميذه الذين عانوا جدًّا من محنة موته الرَّهيبة حتَّى كادوا يفقدون الإيمان به بعد أنْ حُكِمَ عليه بالموت على الصَّليب.

ُهَذَا ٱلنَّصُّ "ظُهُور يُسوعُ للرَّسلُ فيُّ العليَّة" والَّذيُّ يُشكِّل خاتمة إنجيل لوقًا، يشدّد الإنجيليّ على إدخّالنا بإختبار حضور يسوع الحقيقيّ الجديد يُعلَّن يَسُوعَ الْقَائمُ مِن بَينَ الْأَمُواتِ أَنَّ عَلَى هؤَلَاءَ التَّلَامِيذَ أَنَّ يَكُونُوا الشَّهُود ى قيامته. فلم يعد يسوع قابلاً للمعرفة بشهادة الحواس، بل إنَّهٍ هو نفُّسه بِح يُختَلُفُ كُلُّ الإِخْتَلافَ حَيْثِ أَصْحَى حضوره حضورًا جسديًّا مُمجَّدًا. "أُنظَرُواً إلى يديّ ورَجليّ فاتّيّ أنا هو" جاءت بُعَد مرحلَةٌ الضياع والإحباط والشكّ التي عاشها كلّ منِ التكرميذ فإقتنعوا في آخرِ الأمر بحقيقة فيامة يسوع الموت وأصبِحُوا شَهُودًا للقيامة. عرفوه عندما ظَهْرٍ في وسطهم كالم ه حيث رأوه وسمعوه وإستطاعوا أن يلمسوه ورأوة يأكل أمامهم: "قطعة كَ مَشُويٌّ" وَهُو يَرَمُزُ إِلَي الإِفْخَارِسَتِياً "وَمِن شَهْدٌ عَسَلَّ" الَّذِيُّ يُرْمَزُ إِلَى طعام الملوك في العهد القديم رمزًا لملوكيّة يسوع الْقائم والمنتصرِ على الموت. كلّ هٰذا يقودنا آلى البرهان على أن يسوع قام حقًا من بين الأموات في جسده الممجد. إنّ كلّ الأناجيل تؤكّد أنّ هذا الجسد لم يعد هو هو: فالقائم من الموت يظهر ويُغْيب ويجتاز الأبواب المغلقة وجسده لا يُخضّع لحتميات المكّان وَالزُّمَانَ: ۚ إِنَّهُ جِسْمُ رُوحانيُّ كَمَا يقول القدّيسُ بولس: "أَيْزِرع جسمٌ بشريّ فيقوم جُسُمًا رُوْحِيًّا وَإِذَا كَانَ هَنَاكَ جَسُمٌ بَشْرَيٌ فَهَنَاكَ أَيْضًا جُسُمُ رُوحيً (١قو٤٤/٥أ)، هكذا يحوّل الله أجسادنا المائنة ويضّع فيها قوّة القيامة والحياة. إنّ إختبار يسوع القائم من الموت هو جوهر الكيان وجوهر وجودنا نفسه. فُحينَ يَقُولُ الرَّسَلِ: "نَحن شهود عِلَى هَذُه ٱلأمورَ" (أَعْمَالُ الرَّسَلُ٣٢/٥)، ﴾ أنَّهم على يقين تام من أنَّ يسوع هو حيّ. فَهو قد فتح في شخصُمه ابواب الحياة الحقيقيّة أي أنّه هو القيامة

إِنَّ إِخْتَبَارَ القيامةَ فَي حَيَاتَنَا اليُومِ لاَ يَتُمْ إِلاَّ في إكتشاف طريق الحياة التي تمرّ بالموت، فلا بدّ لنا اليوم من أن نموت عن كبريائنا وتسلطنا لكي نحياً لذلك لا نستطيع أن نفهم شريعة الخلاص إلا عبر طريق المحنة والتجربا والفشلِ الذريع الذي يدفعنا إلى أن ندرك عمق ذواتنا.


