## Bishops Message Year of Prayer Pentecost Sunday

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As we celebrate the feast of Pentecost this Sunday, we are reminded of its inseparable connection with the glorious event of Easter. Pentecost is the fruit of Easter, the culmination of the Resurrection event that marks the pinnacle of our faith. Without the Lord's Resurrection from the dead, this feast would not exist in the life of the Church. It is through the Risen Christ who ascended to heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father, that the continuity of his salvific work is affirmed within the embrace of the Church through his accompanying and consoling Holy Spirit. The Resurrection, Ascension, and Pentecost are three events that integrate to bear the fruit of the Holy Spirit within the Church.

On Pentecost, let us consider how the Holy Spirit continues to lead and guide the Church today, just as He has since the beginning. It is the Holy Spirit who ensures that the Church remains a faithful witness to the presence of the Lord and proclaims His Gospel throughout the world. Through the grace of the Spirit, the Church bears the Gospel of Christ in the world today.

The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of the Lord and the Spirit of the Church, giving her life and the ability to continue as a witness to Jesus Christ. Just as the Spirit spoke through the prophets and inspired the writers of the sacred books, He now inspires the Church to discover more of Jesus' identity, presence, and work in the world today.

Let us also reflect on the significance of the Holy Spirit in our individual lives. He dwells within us, transforming us into temples of the Holy Spirit. Through the Spirit, we are enabled to pray and cry out to God as children, confident in our identity as sons and daughters of the Father. We seek to spread the word of God in the world, knowing that our true home is where the Lord Jesus stands at the right hand of the Father.

In this Marian month, let us look to Mary who experienced the Spirit in her unique Pentecost. Our Maronite iconography for this feast portrays her standing at the centre of the disciples in the upper room. In her example, let us strive to carry the Lord to others in the silence of faith and the holiness of life. May we make our lives a continuous hymn of praise to the Lord through the Spirit dwelling within us.

On this Pentecost, the birthday of the Church, may the Holy Spirit continue to guide us to draw ever closer to the heart of the Father. Amen.

# Reflection of the Week: "Pentecost"

We enter today into the longest Season in our Maronite lectionary – the Season of Pentecost. It is dedicated to the ministry of the disciples and is a calling to live our lives through the grace of God's Spirit in us.


The Gospel passage for the commencement of Pentecost is firstly a reminder to keep the commandments. Last week's Gospel presented Jesus' commandment to love one another as Jesus loves us. Pentecost takes up this theme and insists we live it out.

In today's society much is turned into passing fads. Things come and go. People rise in popularity and soon enough end up in obscurity. Nothing seems to endure and hold timeless truths that capture people's minds and hearts.

Today's Gospel is a call to remember Jesus and to ensure his commandment of love is not just another passing fad but an essential element of life.

God does not come and go according to our whims. We are told that God 'abides with you' (v17). There is that enduring knowledge given to us from Jesus, 'that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you' (v20). With this deeply held knowledge of the intimacy of God in our lives, we are assured that God will remain from age to age, despite the rise of non-believers and a society of passing fads and little depth.

'This is the Spirit of truth' (v17) and in this Season of Pentecost we are called to know this truth, to love as Jesus loved, and to make Christ's presence palpable for all. Amen Sr Margaret Ghosn mshf



### كلمة الحياة غذاءً للنفوس

في إنجيل القديس يوحنا، شرحٌ واضحٌ لماهية الروح القدس في حياتنا المسيحية. أولاً، إن يسوع سيسأل الأب بأن يُرسل الروح القدس إلينا. لهذا كان صعود الرب يسوع مهمًا وضروريًّا لنا: ليُعدَّ لنا مُقامًا عند الأب، وليُرسل لنا الروح القدس. فلنطلبُ دومًا من الرّب يسوع بأن يسأل لنا نعمة روحه القدوس في حياتنا وفي حياة الكنيسة جمعاء.

ثانيًا، إن الروح القدس هو البارقليط أي المُدافع والمعزي. فالروح القدس هو من يحرّك حياتنا الروحية نحو الله فيُدافع عنا في أيّام الشدة ويعزّينا في أيام الجفاء. كما وهو المؤيّد أي المُساعد والداعم. فكم من المرات عندما نواجه صعوبات الحياة، نكون بحاجةٍ لهذا الدعم؟ فها هو روح الله حاضرٌ ليؤيّدنا ويعزّينا.

ثالثاً، هو رُوَّح الحق: يُقول الحق ويشهدُ للحق ويقود إلى الحق بالمقابل، يؤنِّب ما هو غير الحق. هو صوت الضمير المقيم فينا، يصرخ عاليًا ليحذّرنا إن خطئنا ويدعونا لنصحّح مسيرنا فنبقى في الحق. <u>https://www.kobayat.org</u>
