

Bishops Message Year of Prayer Trinity Sunday and Feast of Corpus Christi

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The Sunday after Pentecost is Trinity Sunday. In the last verses recorded by the Evangelist Matthew, the Lord gives His disciples the Great Commission: "Go therefore and make disciples in all nations..." (Mt 28:19). This end is actually a beginning, the beginning of the Church. The disciples, in their mission, are accompanied by the Holy Trinity: empowered by the Holy Spirit, promised by the Father, and sent by the Son.

As the Catechism of the Catholic Church states, the mystery of the Holy Trinity is "the central mystery of Christian faith and life." (CCC 261) It is "the mystery of God in himself and the source of all the other mysteries of faith." (CCC 234) This is a profound truth that cannot be fully grasped by human reason alone. However, we are called to accept this truth and seek understanding within the limits of human reason.

The three Persons of the Trinity are co-eternal, sharing the divine essence and nature despite their distinct identities. The Holy Spirit, revealed as the Spirit of God and Christ in the New Testament, is distinct yet equal in essence to the Father and the Son. The Spirit proceeds from the Father through the Son, given to the Church to guide and comfort believers, leading them toward eternal participation in the divine Trinitarian love relationship.

On this Sunday, let us also remember that the Risen Christ is present in our world and in our Church, as he told us at the end of this Sunday's Gospel: "And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age" (Mt 28:20).

The Risen Christ is present in the Church's liturgical prayer, in the Eucharist, and in the lives of the faithful. This awareness of Christ's abiding presence fills us with hope and strengthens us in our mission to proclaim the Gospel and make disciples of all nations, for the Risen Lord is with us always, guiding and empowering the Church until the end of time.

Feast of Corpus Christi

The Feast of Corpus Christi, celebrated on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday, honours the abiding presence of the Risen Lord in the Eucharist. The Eucharist is Jesus Christ's gift of Himself, revealing God's infinite love for every man and woman. On this feast, the Church "shows the world the Corpus Christi—the Body of Christ and invites us to adore him" (John Paul II, 14 June 2001).

I invite all Maronites in Australia to participate in the Corpus Christi processions organised by our Maronite parishes and the Catholic Church. For those in Sydney, I invite you to join the Corpus Christi procession in Punchbowl on Thursday, 30 May 2024. This procession will depart from St John the Beloved Melkite Church in Greenacre at 6:30pm and proceed to St Charbel's Church in Punchbowl.

May we accompany the Bread of Life through the streets of our cities and reveal Christ to everyone through our way of life: through our unity, our joyful faith, and our love.

Reflection of the Week: "Trinity Sunday"

A message for all eternity is the treasure we hold as believers of Christ. The message that all should hear is that God is love and our lives are meant to be lived in love with God.

This Sunday is called Trinity Sunday and comes straight

after Pentecost Sunday, symbolising the fullness of God the Trinity and our invitation to be part of this relationship. In God we belong, and the invitation is always open before each of us. Do we want to be welcomed into God's midst? The disciples are still unsure after witnessing Jesus' death and the unexpected and inexplicable resurrection. This Sunday's Gospel informs us that there were disciples who still 'doubted' (v17). Jesus' response is not to let them wallow in self-pity, or anger, or doubt. Jesus sends them off to make disciples, for it is only in effort and persistence that we can deepen our faith and better appreciate who God is

Christ promises, 'I am with you always, to the end of the age' (v20). It is the one thing we all need and the one thing we are called to share with the world – the knowledge that a God of love is and remains always with us and pours abundant hope and love into our hearts and minds. Amen

كلمة الحياة غذاع للنفوس

"سجدوا له برغم أنهم شكّوا" موقف إيماني مميّز من قبل الرسل. بماذا شكّوا؟ إنّ إطار النص يوحي بأنّهم كانوا لا يزالون غير مصدّقين حقيقة القيامة، التي، وعلى المستوى الإنساني، من الصعب تصديقها بسهولة. إلاّ أنّ موقف التلاميذ تعليميّ بإمتياز، ويشكّل درسًا لكلّ منّا، خاصة في أحد الثالوث الأقدس.

إنّ عقيدة الثالوث الأقدس، وإن كانت الأساس التي عليه يبنى إيماننا، إلّا أنّها تبقى صعبة الفهم، وعرضة للشك من قبلنا كمؤمنين، لأنّه مهما كثرت الشروحات والدراسات والإجتهادات، يبقى من الصعب فهم هذه الحقيقة الإيمانية، كونها تدخل ضمن إطار السرّ، لكن هذا بالضبط ما يشكل نقطة النحوّل!

كثر الكلام عن إستحالة فهم سرّ الثالوث، لكن عندما نقول إنّه سرّ، فهذا يعني أمرين:

- الأمر الأول هو بأن هذا السر يُفهَم تدريجيًا، أو بالأحرى، هو شيء لا يمكن إحتواؤه، يمضي الإنسان كلّ حياته في محاولة فهمه وإكتشافه، ويكتشف فيه كلّ يوم مسألة جديدة وبُعد جديد. هذا يعني علاقة يوميّة، حوار دائم وعلاقة دائمة، حبّ يتجدّد كل يوم، فهل نعيش العلاقة مع الله على هذا الأساس؟
- الأمر الثاني يكمن فيما فعله التلاميذ بركوعهم بالرغم من الشك. إنّ الثالوث ليس مسألة الفهم بقدر ما هو منطق العيش، منطق الحب الذي يعطي كل شيء. إنّ منطق الثالوث يُفهم عندما يُعاش، بالرغم من أنّ العديد من أبعاده هي غير مفهومة. وهذا ما يعلمنا إياه الرسل. فهل نعيش بإيمان منطق الثالوث، وإن كنا غير مقتنعين بالكامل، أو غير فاهمين له؟ هذا هو الإيمان الحقيقي!




