إنْصَرَفَ يَسُوعُ إلى نَواحِي صُورَ وصَيْدا، وإذا بٱمْرَأَةٍ كَنْعَانِيَّةٍ مِنْ تِلْكَ النَّواحي خَرَجَتْ تَصْرُخُ وتَقُول: «إِرْحَهْني، يَا رَبّ، يَا ٱبْنَ دَاوُد! إِنَّ ٱبْنَتِي بِهَا شَيْطَانٌ يُعَذِّبُهَا جدًّا». فَلَمْ يُجبْهَا بِكَلِمَة. ودَنَا تَلامِيذُهُ فَأَخَذُوا يَتَوَسَّلُونَ إلَيْهِ قَائِلين: «إِصْرِفْهَا، فَإِنَّهَا تَصْرُخُ في إثْرِنَا!». فَأَجَابَ وقَال: «لَمْ أَرْسَلْ إِلاَّ إِلَى الْخِرَافِ الضَّالَّةِ مِنْ بَيْتِ إِسْرَائِيل». أَمَّا هِيَ فَأَتَتْ وسَجَدَتْ لَهُ وقَالَتْ: «سَاعِدْنِي، يَا رَبّ!». فَأَجَابَ وقَال: «لا يَحْسُنُ أَنْ يُؤْخَذَ خُبْزُ البَنِين، ويُلْقَى إلى جِرَاءِ الكِلاب!». فقَالَتْ: «نَعَم، يَا رَبّ! وجرَاءُ الكِلاب أَيْضًا تَأْكُلُ مِنَ الفُتَاتِ المُتَسَاقِطِ عَنْ مَائِدَةِ أَرْبَابِهَا». حِينَئِذِ أَجَابَ يَسُوعُ وقَالَ لَهَا: «أَيَّتُهَا ٱلْمَرْأَة، عَظِيْمٌ إِيْمَانُكِ! فَلْيَكُنْ لَكِ كَمَا تُرِيدِين». وَمِنْ تِلْكَ السَّاعَةِ شُفِيَتِ ٱبْنَتْهَا.

Bishops Message Year of Prayer 12th Sunday of Pentecost Beatification of Patriarch Estephan El Douaihy

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Our Maronite Church rejoices with the most joyful celebration of the beatification of Patriarch Estephan El Douaihy on Friday 2 August.

In a world where wars, pandemics, addictions, and laws that go against the will of God are rife, we must never despair. Instead, we should pray unceasingly, placing our trust in God. Through prayer and faith, we can overcome all the challenges that life presents. The grace of the Lord is sufficient for us, and light always drives out darkness.

Despite the world's alienation from God and His Word that our world experiences, we always have hope. This hope is rooted in the eternal truth: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God ... All things came into being through Him... What has come into being in Him was life, and life was the light of all people. Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it" (Jn 1:1-5). The 57th Patriarch of the Maronite Catholic Church, Blessed Estephan El Douaihy, is truly a saint of the Word. He is the saint who embraced the sanctity of the Word, labouring to proclaim the Word of Life and to preserve, nurture, and develop it in the hearts of his people during a time when the world faced trials not unlike those we encounter today.

It is important for all of us to learn more about this great Patriarch. Born in 1630 in Ehden, Lebanon, El Douaihy dedicated himself to a life of scholarship, prayer, and service to the Church. After studying philosophy and theology in Rome, he returned to his homeland, where he served as a preacher, youth educator, and eventually bishop of Cyprus.

In 1670, he was elected Patriarch of the Antiochian Syriac Maronite Church. One of the longest-serving Maronite patriarchs, he led his people for 34 years until 1704. During his long pontificate, Lebanon endured one of its worst and darkest periods under Ottoman rule, which lasted for centuries. Despite the numerous challenges and persecutions he faced, El Douaihy remained a tireless advocate for his flock. A man of thought, mortification, prayer, and good stewardship, he upheld the authority and dignity of the Maronite Church.

As one of the greatest thinkers and theologians of the Maronite Church, Patriarch El Douaihy ranks among the most influential figures of Maronite spiritual leadership. He is also known as "the memory of the Maronite Church" because he was the main founder of the historiography of the Maronite Church, possessing extraordinary knowledge of ancient Maronite documents. He was a pioneer in writing about Maronite liturgy, and the history of Lebanon and the Middle East. Despite facing daunting challenges, he travelled Lebanon on foot, leaving a lasting memory as a saint among his people.

Our Maronite Church is immensely blessed by the life and legacy of this remarkable man of God, who stands as a testament to the power of the Word to transform and heal our troubled world.

It is my prayer that Patriarch El Douaihy's path to sainthood will reignite the fervour of our faith, reminding us of the importance of steadfastness even in the face of adversity. Let us continue to pray for God's Word to bear fruit in our children so that more saints are born in our families. Blessed Estephan El Douaihy, pray for us.

Reflection of the Week: "No Animosity"


Are our enemies really our enemies? Do we have the right to hate people because of their gender, race or creed? Who is deserving of a second chance and who isn't? Our Sunday Gospel passage of the Canaanite woman's faith is a bold announcement that each and every person has a right to be heard and their needs met.

We can think of numerous reasons why we avoid certain people or keep our distance from others. And we all know that there are people that do not quite fit into our way of living and thinking. Our first reaction is to avoid them or be suspicious of them. We believe we have a right to criticise and condemn people because of some dearly held belief that pits us against them.

In today's Gospel we are not given an easy way out. Jesus is confronted by a very demanding woman, who in actual reality should have had nothing to do with him. She was an outsider and a foreigner. She had no right to request anything for her ways and her beliefs were in contrast to Jesus. But that did not stop her, nor Jesus!

When we can stop and allow conversation to happen and permit ourselves to listen to the other without any assumptions, we soon find that we are all very much people with the same needs, requests and hopes. It doesn't matter where we are from, what we believe and how we are. What brings us together is our humanitarian sense. Mercy and love speak louder and more profoundly than anything else. Amen

كلمة الحياة غذاءً للنفوس

ظاهريًّا، المعجزة التي يخبر عنها إنجيل المرأة الكنعانيّة هي شفاء إبنة المرأة الكنعانية، إنّما بالحقيقة تكمن المعجزة الحقيقية في إيمان المرأة، التي هي في الأصل وثنية، لا تعرف الله، إلّا أنّها بر هنت عن إيمان يتخطى بكثير إيمان الّذين يؤمنون بالله، حتّى التلاميذ بذاتهم. تعامل التلاميذ مع المرأة ومع الرّب على أساس مبدأ "الإستحقاق": هي غير مؤمنة، لا تستحق أن تقترب من الرّب ولا أن تطلب منه شيئًا، وهذا ما يفسّر ردّة فعلهم وإنز عاجهم منها. إلا أن الغريب في الأمر هو ردة فعل الرّب، الذي بدا وكأنّه يتبنى هذا الفكر.

في الواقع، ليست المسألة كذلك، بل إن الرّب يردد ما يعتبره التلاميذ حقيقة ليختبر إيمان المرأة، ليس لأنه لا يعرف ماذا ستجيبه، بل لأن جوابها سيشكّل درسًا للرسل وللجميع، لأنه سيقدم إيمان المرأة، التي لا تعرف الله، كإيمان نموذجي، يتخطّى بكثير إيمان الرسل والشعب اليهودي، الّذين يعتبرون أنفسهم مختارين ومؤمنين ويعرفون الله بالعمق. بيّن يسوع من خلال حواره مع المرأة ومن خلال جوابها أن الإقتراب منه ليس مسألة إستحقاق، لأن لا أحد يستحق، وليست مسألة بأنه "يحق لي أن أطلب منه" لأني أفضل من غيري، أو لأني أتمم ما يطلبه مني، بل بإقترابي من الرّب بثقة، منتظرًا بتواضع خلاصه كما يريد هو، وليس كما أتصوّر أنا !
